
Methodology

- Final Sample 2022: N = 2,609




30-day substance use (* First asked in 2014)




Past year non-prescribed prescription use (* First asked in 2014)




Recency of alcohol use




Binge drinking




Consequences of drinking (experienced at least once in past year)
