



#### **DEA Reports Widespread Threat of Fentanyl Mixed with Xylazine**

**WASHINGTON** – The U.S. Drug Enforcement Administration is warning the American public of a sharp increase in the trafficking of fentanyl mixed with xylazine. Xylazine, also known as "Tranq," is a powerful sedative that the U.S. Food and Drug Administration has approved for veterinary use.

"Xylazine is making the deadliest drug threat our country has every faced, fentanyl, even deadlier," said Administrator Milgram. "DEA has seized xylazine and fentanyl mixtures in 48 of 50 States. The DEA Laboratory System is reporting that in 2022 approximately 23% of fentanyl powder and 7% of fentanyl pills seized by the DEA contained xylazine."

Xylazine and fentanyl drug mixtures place users at a higher risk of suffering a fatal drug poisoning. Because xylazine is not an opioid, naloxone (Narcan) does not reverse its effects. Still, experts always recommend administering naloxone if someone might be suffering a drug poisoning. People who inject drug mixtures containing xylazine also can develop severe wounds, including necrosis—the rotting of human tissue—that may lead to amputation.

## **Arizona Drug Threat**



All drugs are readily available in Arizona



- Increasing demand for fentanyl and methamphetamine
- Arizona is a key transshipment state for Sinaloa Cartel drug shipments
- Distribution networks based in Phoenix and Tucson
- Majority of drug shipments transiting Arizona are destined for U.S. drug markets

## **Arizona Drug Threat**




- Arizona is the primary smuggling corridor for fake M-30 fentanyl pills
- Dramatic rise in the number of fake pills containing at least 2mg of fentanyl
- DEA Phoenix Division fentanyl pill seizures
   29.2 million fentanyl pills (2022)
   Over 29 million fentanyl pills (YTD 2023)



#### Problem Statement

Fentanyl, a synthetic opioid, is being laced in a wide variety of drugs that are easily accessible to youth. The use of dealing online has made the ability to buy counterfeit drugs almost effortless. Fentanyl is extremely lethal in small doses, easy to lace and can be disguised as candy. At schools, social pressures, a lack of education, a lack of narcan and help for those who are using drugs has also aided in the increase of overdoses and deaths in recent years.



### **SMART Goals**

- #1 (Student): 75% of TUHSD high school students will have knowledge of the lethalness & accessibility of fentanyl by 75% by May 22, 2024.
- #2 (Community): 20% overall response rate from fentanyl awareness surveys and activities among families in the TUHSD by May 22, 2024.


